

GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 1163

An ordinance amending General Ordinance Number 928 in the City of Kendallville, Noble County, State of Indiana, such ordinance being known as the *Zoning Code for the City of Kendallville, Indiana*, by changing the classification districting and uses of the real estate more fully described in this ordinance from C-2A, General Commercial district to R-2, One and Two Family district.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Kendallville, Indiana:

SECTION 1. That General Ordinance Number 928 being known as the *Zoning Regulations of Kendallville, Indiana, 1998*, is hereby amended so that the following described real estate located in Noble County, State of Indiana, to-wit:


- Lot 299 of Mitchells Addition to the City of Kendallville, a.k.a. 121 S. Grant Street
- Lot 300 of Mitchells Addition to the City of Kendallville, a.k.a. 119 S. Grant Street
- Lot 301 of Mitchells Addition to the City of Kendallville, a.k.a. 117 S. Grant Street


be changed from C-2A, General Commercial district to R-2, One and Two Family district.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval by the Mayor.




